We have been reading Warlalja books. We have now got workbooks to do English and Maths worksheets everyday! The pool is open again so we have been swimming everyday and having lots of fun.




















We have been writing out the alphabet and tracing our letters. We have been learning about shapes, writing their names, drawing them and watching videos about them. We have been reading Warlpiri books.
